

## **COVID-19 Golf Guidelines**

The spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) in British Columbia and around the world has raised concerns for everyone in these trying times. Bootleg Gap Golf values the well-being of our staff and customers. We want you to know that your health & safety will remain our top priority as this situation continues to evolve.

Bootleg Gap Golf is following the lead of public health authorities and doing our part to limit the spread of the virus.

Here are the guidelines that guests must follow while golfing at Bootleg Gap Golf -

### Golfers:

- STAY HOME – If you are experiencing COVID-19 Symptoms. The most common symptoms are fever, dry cough, difficulty breathing and loss of energy.
- STAY HOME – If you have traveled within the past 14 days.
- STAY HOME – If someone in your household has COVID-19 Symptoms.
- Respect the 2-metre social distancing at all times.
- Limit touch points and only handle your own golf equipment.
- Masks are required indoors

### Arrival/Check In:

- No outside alcohol is permitted; it is the law.
- Only 4 golfers allowed in the Pro Shop at one time.
- Debit or Credit touchless tap payment available in the Pro Shop.
- Please sanitize your hands prior to shopping in the Pro Shop.
- The driving range and practice greens are open. A warm up bucket is provided with every paid green fee.

### Power Carts:

- We will be implementing a new cleaning protocol on power and pull carts after each round to ensure proper disinfection.
- Coolers have been removed.
- We ask that golfers empty garbage and recycling into supplied bins following their round.

## Golfing:

- Maintain social distancing throughout the course.
- Proceed to the 1<sup>st</sup> tee once the group ahead has left the tee.
- Do not touch the flagstick. Cups will be flipped upside down so golfers can pick up their ball without touching the flagstick.
- We recommend continuous putting. Consider a gimme length within your group.
- Marshalls will be on the course monitoring pace of play and social distancing.
- Groups will not play through other groups. Keep an appropriate pace whether you're in a group of 2, 3 or 4.
- Rakes will be removed from the bunkers. Preferred lies in the bunkers, smooth the sand with your foot after your shot.
- Ball washers and garbage cans have been removed from the tee boxes. Please use the supplied garbage and recycling bins following your round.
- On-course washrooms are frequently cleaned and sanitized throughout the day.

## After your round:

- Park your cart at the designated cart return area so it can be disinfected.
- Please remove all garbage and recycling from your cart and place in the bins provided.
- Please proceed directly to the clubhouse or your car. Do not congregate around the 18<sup>th</sup> green after your round.

## Food & Beverage:

- The clubhouse will be open with limited hours of operation. Monday to Thursday 11:00am – 8:30pm, Friday to Sunday 7:00am – 8:30pm.
- We have a large clubhouse and patio area. Our tables will be set-up to maximize social distancing.
- Masks are required when not seated at your table.

## Additional:

- The on course washrooms located at the #2 tee, #6 tee and #15 tee will be open. Please sanitize your hands before you enter.
- In the event of inclement weather, please return to your car until the course is safe for play.
- Surfaces and touch points will be cleaned and sanitized regularly to ensure guest and staff safety.

We will review the above protocols and regulations regularly, and if all is going well, we hope to gradually add more services back into operations, if they can be managed safely.
